### **Our Conductor**

**Elena Varshavskaya** graduated from Moscow State P. I. Tchaikovsky Conservatory with Honors in 2002 majoring in choral conducting. While studying at the conservatory, she was a member of the Moscow Conservatory Chamber Choir and participated in international choral music competitions and festivals, both in Russia and abroad touring Italy, Germany, Austria and Poland. In 2002 Elena was the Artistic Director and Conductor of the Chamber Choir 'Lad' which successfully toured Greece, Germany and Finland and also received gold and silver awards at the 5th International Johannes Brahms Choir Competition, Wernigerode, Germany in 2005.

In 2010 Elena joined the Melbourne Symphony Orchestra Choir as a chorister, and in 2011 became Musical Director of Bendigo Chorale where she has directed and conducted many concerts for the choir in Bendigo, Echuca and Melbourne and also participated in projects with David Kram (More Than Opera) and Victorian Opera. Elena also works with a community choir 'Nostalgia'. Her repertoire includes classical music, contemporary music, jazz, gospel and folk, including works by Rachmaninoff, Mozart, Andrew Lloyd Webber, Gershwin and Rutter. She also leads the Children Choral Studio 'Harmony'.

# **Organist**

**Hugh Fullarton** FRCO ARCM B.Mus(Melb) Dip.Ed(Melb) LMusA, is an Australian organist, pianist, conductor, composer, and improviser Hugh Fullarton has established a significant reputation for his dynamic performances, compositions, and fluency across diverse musical genres. He studied pipe organ with internationally renowned John O'Donnell at the University of Melbourne, receiving the highest marks in performance in his undergraduate and postgraduate degrees and winning a number of prizes. He is a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists, one of only a handful of Australians to have been awarded this pre-eminent diploma over the last few decades, and also holds an Associate Diploma in Organ Performance from the Royal College of Music, London. As organist or pianist he has appeared with King's College Choir Cambridge, Winchester Cathedral Choir, Melbourne Symphony Orchestra, The Consort of Melbourne, The Sydney Chamber Choir, Trinity College Choir at The University of Melbourne, The Australian Boys Choir, and The Australian Choral Symposium, amongst a host of other local ensembles. He has performed as an organ soloist throughout Australia and England, and had solo recitals broadcast on ABC FM and 3MBS FM.

## Soloist

Kate Amos is fast becoming one of Australia's most artistically versatile and highly sought-after young sopranos. She holds a Bachelor of Music (Performance) with Honours, Diploma in Languages (Italian) and Masters of Music (Opera Performance) from The University of Melbourne. She also holds an Advanced Masters in Opera from the Welsh International Academy of Voice, Cardiff studying under the tutelage of renowned international tenor Dennis O'Neill. Making her debut with the Sydney Symphony Orchestra in 2016, Kate performed the Fauré Requiem at Sydney's City Recital Hall, and portrayed Milly in the Australian premiere of Williamson's *Our Man in Havana* with Lyric Opera of Melbourne, for which she was awarded 'Best Actress in a Supporting Role in an Opera' by The Australian and Opera Chaser critic; Paul Selar. She sang the role of Christine in *The Phantom of the Opera* (Windmill Theatre) earning Kate the Lyrebird Award for 'Best Actress in Leading Role in a Musical'. Her concert works include: Fauré Requiem, Brahms Requiem (St. Martin-in-the-Fields, debut; London), Mozart's Exultate Jubilate and Brahms Liebeslieder Op. 52. In 2019, Kate was delighted to make her Principal Artist mainstage debut with Opera Australia as 'Arkie Whiteley' in *Whiteley*. Numerous awards consist of the Melbourne Male Welsh Choir Singer of the Year; 2016-2017, Sleath Lowrey scholarship 2014; Lisa Gasteen National Opera scholarship 2014; AME 'Opera Scholar of the Year' joint-winner 2011.
