


Glen Eira City Choir are rehearsing in the St Andrew's Parish Hall using the side entrance to the building, off the covered walkway – Vicar's Walk – between the new Brighton Grammar School building (Duigan Centre) and the 1920's Parish Hall building.



THERE ARE THREE WAYS TO ACCESS THE ENTRANCE TO THE ST ANDREW'S PARISH HALL

1. **St Andrew's Street** (parallel street parking, also Black St) – simplest, closest, slight slope
2. **Church St** (angle street parking) – steps or ramp with heavy large glass doors esp. in windy conditions
3. **Car Park 228 New Street** – furthest and level




PARISH HALL

FROM ST ANDREW'S STREET

Walk up the path between the red brick hall building and the entrance to the underground car park for the new school building



Go through the automatic sliding doors (this view is looking out to St Andrew's St)



The entrance to the hall is immediately on your left



FROM CHURCH STREET

Walk up the path to the left of Mazi Café
toward the front right of the church

LEFT path – ramp

RIGHT path – 2 steps with handrails



LEFT path

by church building
up the ramp

through the glass door

note: door is quite
heavy



RIGHT path

along the red brick hall
(past the old entrance),
up the steps

through the glass door



turn right

along Vicars Walk






Continue along Vicars Walk

between the school building and the and hall
toward the sliding doors out to St Andrew's St



Entry is on your right just before the sliding
doors




FROM THE CHURCH CAR PARK 228 New Street

Follow the path to the LEFT around the church building - this path is level and well lit.
(The driveway to the right off the car park is not well lit and the surface is uneven in parts).

You will end up on the other side of the church to the car park in the **Eastern Courtyard.**


Take the path on the left



Turn right along the school building (heading to Church St),



Turn left at the end (T intersection)
and walk between the school building and the hall
toward the sliding doors out to St Andrew's St



Entry is on your right
just before the sliding doors
